



First Reconciliation and First Eucharist Preparation 2021-2022

Children who are in second grade will participate in Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.

- Children who attend a public school or are home-schooled must register for second grade Faith Formation.
- Children who attend a Catholic School do not need to register for Faith Formation.

All children in second grade will participate in other First Reconciliation and First Eucharist activities throughout the year, in-person and/or virtually. A schedule will be provided at the beginning of the school year.

Children in third grade who attend a public school or who are home-schooled and have not received First Eucharist must register for Faith Formation. They will also participate in First Eucharist activities throughout the year.

Children in grades 4 – 8 who attend a public school or who are home-schooled and have not received First Eucharist must register for the grade-appropriate Faith Formation class, and will receive additional individual preparation outside of class time.

Children in grades 3 – 8 who attend a Catholic School and have not received First Eucharist will receive additional individual preparation. These are handled on a case-by-case basis.

Children must be baptized prior to receiving First Eucharist. Any child baptized in a church other than Immaculate Conception must provide a Baptismal Certificate. Children of families who are **not** registered parishioners of Immaculate Conception Parish must register as a parishioner or receive permission for the reception of the Sacraments from their pastor.

An **Application for the Reception of Holy Eucharist** must be completed and returned with the fee. Forms are available and can be submitted directly on the parish website at <https://icfayetteville.org/faith-formation/elementary-junior-high/>

The **Sacramental Fee** is \$40. Fees can be paid when registering through on-line giving, by **cash** or **check** (made out to **Immaculate Conception Parish**) and mailed to Immaculate Conception, 400 Salt Springs St, Fayetteville, NY 13066.
