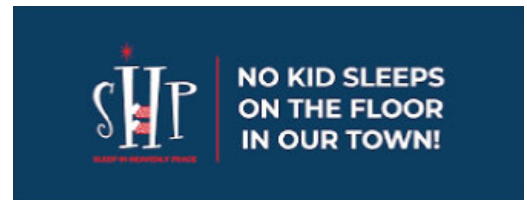

FISHERMAN'S CLUB OF THE SYRACUSE DIOCESE

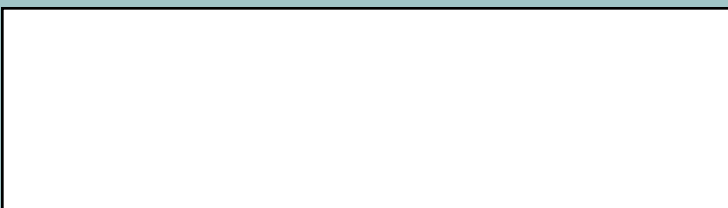

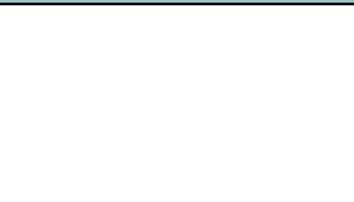

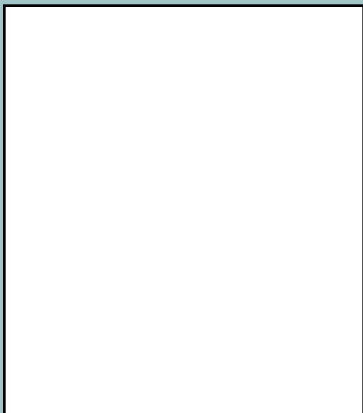
