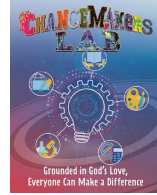
We have 70 students who have received First Eucharist this spring over May 2nd and May 9th.

FAITH MATTERS

It may not come as a surprise to you that Mother's Day, in some form or another, is celebrated in at least forty countries around the world and has been since ancient times in many cultures (e.g. the Greeks and Romans), but it was only in the early 20th Century that it became official in the U.S. The woman who started it here, Anna Jarvis, did so in her own Methodist Episcopal Church in 1908 as a liturgical celebration to honor women's work and their role in the family. She decried the commercialization that crept in even in her day. She had envisioned it as a day set aside for visits, notes or simple expressions of love for mothers. Though many of us feel this day has become way too commercialized, there are good reasons to honor our mothers living or deceased.

Through sheer happenstance, I learned about some amazing mothers who deserve our honor. I began thinking about the power of prayer when mothers are determined.

While listening to an interview on my digital Catholic Sun with two mothers; one the mother of a newly ordained priest and the other the mother of a seminarian preparing for his deaconate year, I heard for the first time about the Mothers of Lu. I couldn't help but wonder where I have been since I knew nothing of these amazing women or of their influence on Catholic mothers around the globe. Perhaps this dedicated group of moms is also new to you.

First, Lu is a tiny village of about 4,000 people in Northwestern Italy near Turin. That's an important fact since what the moms in this small village accomplished beginning in 1881 is almost unbelievable! These were moms of deep faith who loved their church and their pastor and, who, under his guidance began an amazing life of prayer. The pastor, Monsignor Alessandro Canora, suggested that the mothers offer their Holy Communion once a month for the intention of fostering vocations. Soon they began saying a special prayer for vocations

after every mass and, eventually, they began gathering every Tuesday for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament praying always for vocations to religious life and to the priesthood.

Over the next fifty years from the small village of Lu, 152 priests and 171 nuns answered the call of God to serve the Church! Inspired by these holy women, groups of moms have formed around the world, including in Syracuse and Rochester, to emulate the Mothers of Lu. In this day, when our own dear priests are overwhelmed with leading two, three, four, and even five parishes, wouldn't it behoove us mothers, grandmothers and all women of Immaculate Conception on this Mother's Day to pray for more vocations to the priesthood as well as more people to answer God's call to religious life? Or- begin our own Mothers of IC (Lu)?
